LiveHealth Online

Employees and their family members who are covered under the County's health insurance plan have an alternative to going to wait in the doctor's office or a walk-in clinic for minor health issues. You can use your smart-phone, tablet, or computer with a webcam to see a board-certified doctor in minutes by accessing LiveHealthOnline through Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia.



To use this feature, sign up at livehealthonline.com or download the app. You have access 24/7 to doctors who can assess your condition, provide treatment options, and even send a prescription to the pharmacy of your choice, if needed. It's medical care when you need it for conditions such as the flu, sinus infection, pink eye, rashes, fevers, and more. It's convenient, with no appointments or long waits, and you can usually be connected to a doctor in about 10 minutes or less. Rather than paying a doctor for their normal office visit charge, you pay only a \$5 co-pay for the convenience of using this excellent benefit.
